Emergency appointment

Immediate danger of death or serious harm or deterioration to the physical or mental health of the person; or

Serious loss to property; and

The person needs decisions to be made to prevent the danger

Emergency Intervention

the incapable person is or is likely to be abused or to suffer neglect; and
