

## Now Recruiting Board Members

More than 20,300 people in Manitoba are currently living with Alzheimer's disease or another form of dementia. This number is growing quickly and is expected to reach over 39,100 by 2050. In addition, 62% of Manitobans have had a close friend or family member diagnosed with dementia.

We are currently recruiting two board members and are committed to enhancing the diversity of our board. We encourage applications from individuals across Manitoba with a wide range of backgrounds, experiences and perspectives. Meetings may be attended virtually. Successful candidates will be required to submit a criminal record check.

We're looking for candidates who:

- Are willing to review and, when needed, help strengthen the Society's values and vision
- Think strategically and focus on the future
- Are comfortable helping shape direction, not just approving decisions
- Act with integrity and courage
- Work well as part of a respectful, ethical and high performing team
- Understand the importance of delegating day to day operations to staff

What to expect:

- Board members may serve up to two consecutive three year terms
- The Chief Executive Officer leads a professional team with an annual budget of approximately \$4 million and serves 6,000 clients
- Directors and Officers Liability insurance is provided
- The Board meets six times per year and follows the Carver Policy Governance® model, which focuses on outcomes rather than operations

Board members are not compensated financially. The reward is the opportunity to make a meaningful difference in the lives of people affected by dementia and those who care for them.
